Translate Field Options Plugin

Introduction


Translate Field Options Plugin adds the ability to translate the options field (checkbox, radio, list).

Using the Jira interface, we add extra functionality in all the options in our fields, since we do not currently have it.

Our add-on adds four custom fields - checkbox, radiobutton, list and list extended - with the possibility of translating, **for each language installed in JIRA**, all the options in that field.

Installation

- Access to JIRA with user with permissions - JIRA Administrators
- Go to addons administration
'Administration' > 'Add-ons' > 'Find New Add-ons'




- In "Search the Marketplace" enter text "Translate Field Options".
- Click in 'Buy Now' or 'Free Trial'. Once installed this plugin, display a message that plugin has been installed correctly.

Configuration

After add-on installation, we have to create a new translated field.

In this example we have created a new Checkbox:

'Administration' > 'Issues' > 'Custom Fields' -> add custom field and we choose checkbox:



Translate Options Field

Once our field has been added to the corresponding screens, we must translate the values.

Go to - Administration >Issues >Custom Fields. We will choose our field and click “Configure”.

Next, we add the values of the options, by default. These values will be shown in case they have no translation.

In our case we have added, name of countries in English language.


